BEFORE YOU TRAVEL

At least 24 hours prior to your arrival in Colombia and again before departing the country, all travelers must complete the mandatory Check-Mig form required by Colombian immigration authorities.

Your passport must be valid for a minimum of six (6) months from the date of entry. Comprehensive international travel insurance covering medical assistance, accidents, and unforeseen circumstances is strongly recommended.

Yellow fever vaccination is advised for certain regions and must be administered at least ten (10) days prior to travel. Please keep your vaccination certificate available, either in digital or printed format, as authorities may request it.

ESSENTIAL TRAVEL INFORMATION

Domestic flight schedules may be subject to changes due to weather conditions or force majeure circumstances.

Any modification to scheduled activities or transfers must be requested at least 24 hours in advance and is subject to availability.

Currency exchange at airports is not recommended. Your private guide will gladly suggest reliable and fairly rated exchange locations.

The local currency is the Colombian Peso (COP). Credit cards are widely accepted in major cities; however, carrying cash is advisable when traveling to remote regions.

REGIONAL REQUIREMENTS & EXCLUSIVE CONDITIONS

Rosario Islands (Cartagena): An environmental contribution of COP 30,000 (approximately USD 8) is required to support the preservation of the Corales del Rosario National Natural Park.

Additionally, a mandatory local medical insurance applies: COP 8,000 per day (approximately USD 4).

San Andrés & Providencia Archipelago: A mandatory tourist card must be purchased upon arrival (COP 146,000 – approximately USD 40).

Remote destinations such as the Amazon, Nuquí, Bahía Solano, La Macarena, and La Guajira require a maximum luggage allowance of 15 kg due to logistical and transportation limitations.

CONNECTIVITY & ELECTRICITY

Local SIM cards are readily available upon arrival for approximately COP 40,000 (around USD 10).

Electrical voltage in Colombia is 110V, using type A/B plugs. A universal travel adapter is recommended.

HEALTH, SAFETY & COMFORT

Insect repellent is highly recommended, particularly in jungle, coastal, and tropical regions.

Due to strong sun exposure, sunscreen, hats, and sunglasses are essential.

We advise guests to avoid displaying valuable items in public areas and to rely exclusively on authorized transportation services.

Always follow the recommendations of your private guide to ensure a seamless and secure travel experience.
